Corporate Volunteering Program

The Comfort & Care program is at the very core of RMHC Bay Area's mission to provide essential services that remove barriers, strengthen families, and promote healing when children need healthcare. From snack packs to bedside activity kits, your team can provide comfort and care to families during long days at the hospital. Families often say, "It means so much to know that people out there think about us and care."

Each year, our goal is to distribute 12,000 Comfort & Care Kits to families at each hospital served by our Stanford, San Francisco, and Oakland locations. We rely on teams like you to reach this goal.

All Comfort & Care volunteer activities include:

- A mission presentation for your team by an RMHC Bay Area staff member
- Curated Comfort & Care Kit items to be packaged during the activity
- Packaging materials
- Option to included branded SWAG (provided by you)
- Options to either host your team activity at Ronald McDonald House at Stanford with a facility tour or to set up the activity at your workplace

Choose the option that best fits your group size and availability.

Groups under 10 individuals:

- Activity duration: 90 minutes
- Produces 200 bedside kits
- Sponsorship amount: \$1,200

Groups with 15-25 individuals:

- Activity duration: 90 minutes
- Produces 600 bedside kits
- Sponsorship amount: \$3,600

Groups with 10-15 individuals:

- Activity duration: 90 minutes
- Produces 400 bedside kits
- Sponsorship amount: \$2,400
